

Patron Registration

Policy 1.5

- I. The Library will issue library cards, without charge, to all residents or property owners within the Hyde Park Library District. The District is defined by statute as “the town of Hyde Park, except those portions of such town that are within the Staatsburg Fire District or the Hillside Fire District.”
 - A. Adult patrons must present photo identification and proof of a current address to receive a library card.
 - B. For minors under the age of sixteen to receive a library card, documentation for a parent or legal guardian is required.
- II. Library card holders have universal borrowing privileges throughout the Mid-Hudson Library System.
- III. The Library will issue library cards, without charge, to residents of other communities within the Mid-Hudson Library System service area and forward registration information to the patron’s “home library.”
- IV. The Library Director may, at his or her discretion, authorize the issuance of library cards to patrons outside the Mid-Hudson Library System service area.
- V. The Library reserves the right to charge a fee for replacement cards.
