

BOARD ELECTION AND BUDGET VOTE INFORMATION

The Hyde Park Library District has announced its proposed budget for 2024. The current 2023 budget factoring in all funding streams is \$508,101. The proposed budget for 2024, as voted on by the library board, is \$528,996.

Of the total proposed budget, the amount proposed to be raised via tax levy for 2024 is **\$512,296**. This is the amount that voters in the District will be asked to vote upon on Thursday, October 12th.

The total proposed increase in the tax levy would be \$24,395.

The current tax levy on residents of the district is \$487,901.

The vote will take place on Thursday, October 12th at the Hyde Park Free Library. Polling hours will be from 2:00PM to 9:00PM.

Registered voters in the Hyde Park Library District (the town of Hyde Park excluding those in the Staatsburg and Hillside fire districts) may cast their votes at that time. For information on absentee ballots, please call (845)229-7791 extension 205.

Copies of the proposed budget are available for public review at the library's main office.

In addition to the budget vote, two full-term seats on the library board will be up for vote in October as well. These terms are for a five year period. In addition, three vacant positions on the board for more limited terms will also be subject to vote at this time.
